

Do you support the creation of a \$1.75 per credit fee to fund Brock University Student Radio (CFBU) starting Spring 2019, as per the Memorandum of Understanding?

Memorandum of Understanding

Brock University Student Radio Levy
October 2018

As per the referendum question being proposed to the undergraduate students at Brock University; this is a campus-wide referendum;

1. The Brock University Student Radio Levy shall be a \$1.75 per credit charge, levied to all undergraduate students, both full-time and part-time. It shall be levied in all academic sessions and durations. This levy shall be mandatory.
2. The Brock University Student Radio levy shall be charged on courses beginning with the 2019 Spring session.
3. All monies collected from the Brock University Student Radio Levy shall be forwarded to Brock University Student Radio and shall be spent according to an annual budget approved by Brock University Student Radio.
4. Brock University Student Radio will provide the Brock University Student's Union Board of Directors with a copy of their budget by July 31 each year.
5. Any monies collected from the Brock University Student Radio Levy, not spent by Brock University Student Radio shall remain as retained earnings for Brock University Student Radio.
6. Brock University Student Radio agrees to hire an auditor, external to Brock University, for their annual financial audit. A copy of the audit will be provided to BUSU and will be made available online.
7. One (1) BUSU Executive (selected by BUSU) will sit on the Brock University Student Radio Board of Directors as a non-voting member. The members of Brock University Student Radio will vote to ratify the candidate.
8. In the event that the BUSU Board of Directors determines that Brock University Student Radio is in violation of the terms of the Levy Memorandum of Understanding, they reserve the right to withhold the levy transfer to Brock Student Radio until the violations have been remedied. Any withheld levy will be frozen in trust.
