

Do you support the transfer of a \$2.75 per credit fee from the Brock Student Sexual Violence Support Centre (A Safer Brock) to fund an on-campus sexual violence education and support service provider, as per the Memorandum of Understanding?

Memorandum of Understanding

1. The purpose of the student levy transfer from A Safer Brock to an on-campus sexual violence education and support service provider is to offer students:
 - a. Accessible and immediate access to sexual violence education and support in the heart of student life and activity;
 - b. A set of highly qualified and experienced personnel;
 - c. Transparent fiscal and operating practices.
2. The on-campus sexual violence education and support service provider shall be the Human Rights and Equity (HRE) department who report directly to Brock University's President.
3. The transfer of the student levy will result in the automatic defunding of A Safer Brock.
4. HRE will replace existing sexual violence educative and support services offered by A Safer Brock and substantially increase the scope of support service, training and educative initiatives including but not limited to the following:
 - a. Survivor Support Services: drop-in site, survivor support groups, peer support networks, increased disclosure intake persons;
 - b. Increased Trauma-Informed Counselling on-campus;
 - c. On-Campus Training and Programming: consent, active bystander, empathy and disclosure, masculinity, cultural bias, unconscious bias, violence continuum and trauma integration.
 - d. 24/7 support;
 - e. Advocacy, court support and practical assistance;
 - f. Educative workshops, campaigns and speaker series to staff, faculty and students;
 - g. External training and conference opportunities for students;
 - h. Disclosure services and interventions: presence in school, classes, and activities.
 - i. Respondent support: restorative justice practices and supporting programming.
 - j. Diverse network of support services and partnerships: multilingual services including counselling, access to Brock media outlets, access to internal systems to streamline service and initiatives.
5. HRE will maintain accountability measures including but not limited to:
 - a. Offer regular presentations on service, initiatives and budget to Brock University Students' Union (BUSU) Board of Directors and Brock University Student Administrative Counsel (BUSAC);
 - b. Quarterly presentations to Brock University Board;
 - c. Offer financial statements to BUSU Board, BUSAC and Senior Staff.
6. The transfer of the student levy shall occur Spring 2019 and apply to both full-time and part-time students in all academic sessions and durations. This shall be a mandatory fee.

7. The levy may increase annually by *up to* 5% to however such an increase shall be subject to approval from the BUSU Board of Directors or their designate.
